Thank you for joining us at Apple Pie Day to visit legislators! This short and simple visit will go far in helping to protect and expand homeschool freedoms in Oregon.

Below is an example script for the conversation. Feel free to use your own wording! Note that you aren't necessarily assigned to the legislator in your district, so the discussion will be general. Also, the legislator will often not be at their desk when you visit. That's ok! Staffers also play an essential role, so have the conversation with them instead and drop off the pie and info flyer for the legislator to enjoy later.
