Progress, not perfection




Make Time Together in God's Word THE Priority

Teach Them to Memorize and Meditate on God's Word

- Use various methods for memorization (songs, hand motions, visual cues, etc.)









Help Them Get Familiar with the Bible








Help Them Engage with Scripture

Let the Gospel Be On the Tip of Your Tongue

- Start simple
- Repeat and rephrase often
- Weave it into Bible conversations
- When you instruct or correct
- Expand their understanding as they grow

Teach Them to Pray


- Mealtime prayer rotation


Teach Them to Study God's Word

- Give them study tools to choose from


Dig Into Worldview & Theology

- And more!






